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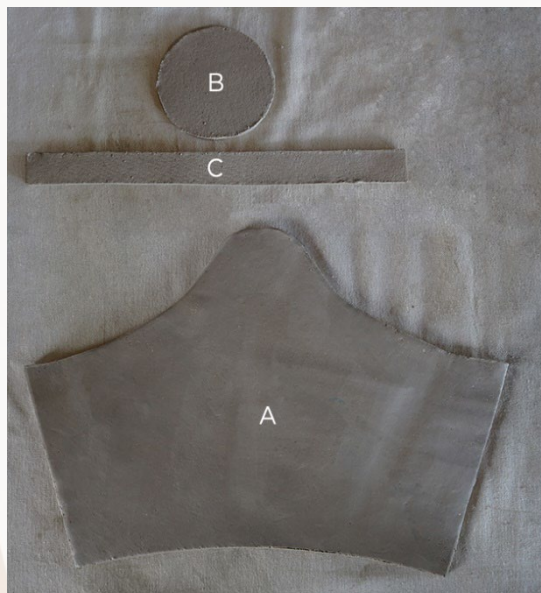

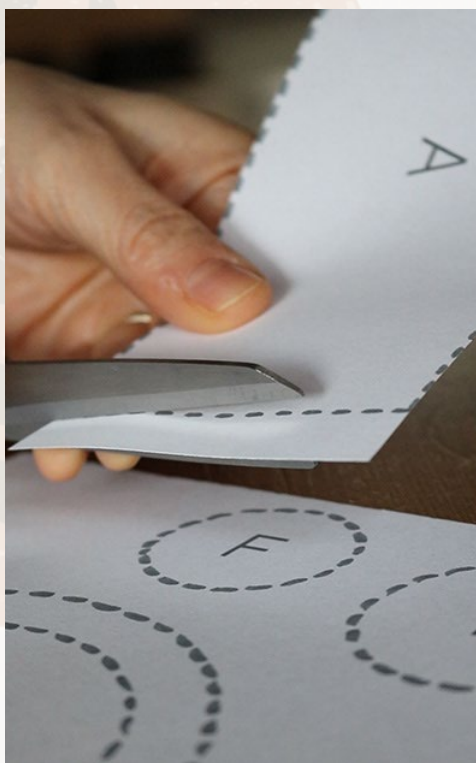

Instructions



These are the parts you need for your jug.



1. Cut out the templates along the dotted line on the outside.

You can find it at the end of this document.



2. Roll out a 1 cm thick slab of clay and place your templates.

3. Template A are created in double length.

Please place the second half directly on the recess for the spout.





4. Take part A and connect the ends well.

Make sure that you have roughened them beforehand and applied a bit slip.

5. Make sure you smooth the connection well – inside and outside.





6. Part B is now prepared for connection to part A. Part B forms the base of the jug.

7. Place part A on top of part B and connect the parts.





8. Connect them well –
inside and outside.

9. Take a wooden
spoon or another
stick of your choice.
Place it in the spout
and squeeze the
sides from the other
side with your hand.





10. You can press your jug so that it has exactly the shape you like.

11. You can also press the spout into your desired shape.





12. Now place part C - the handle - in the exact shape you want for your jug and allow it to dry a little or heat it up a with a hair dryer.

13. Scratch the handle and the jug in the desired places and apply slip.





14. Place your handle.

15. Add some clay to create soft transitions.

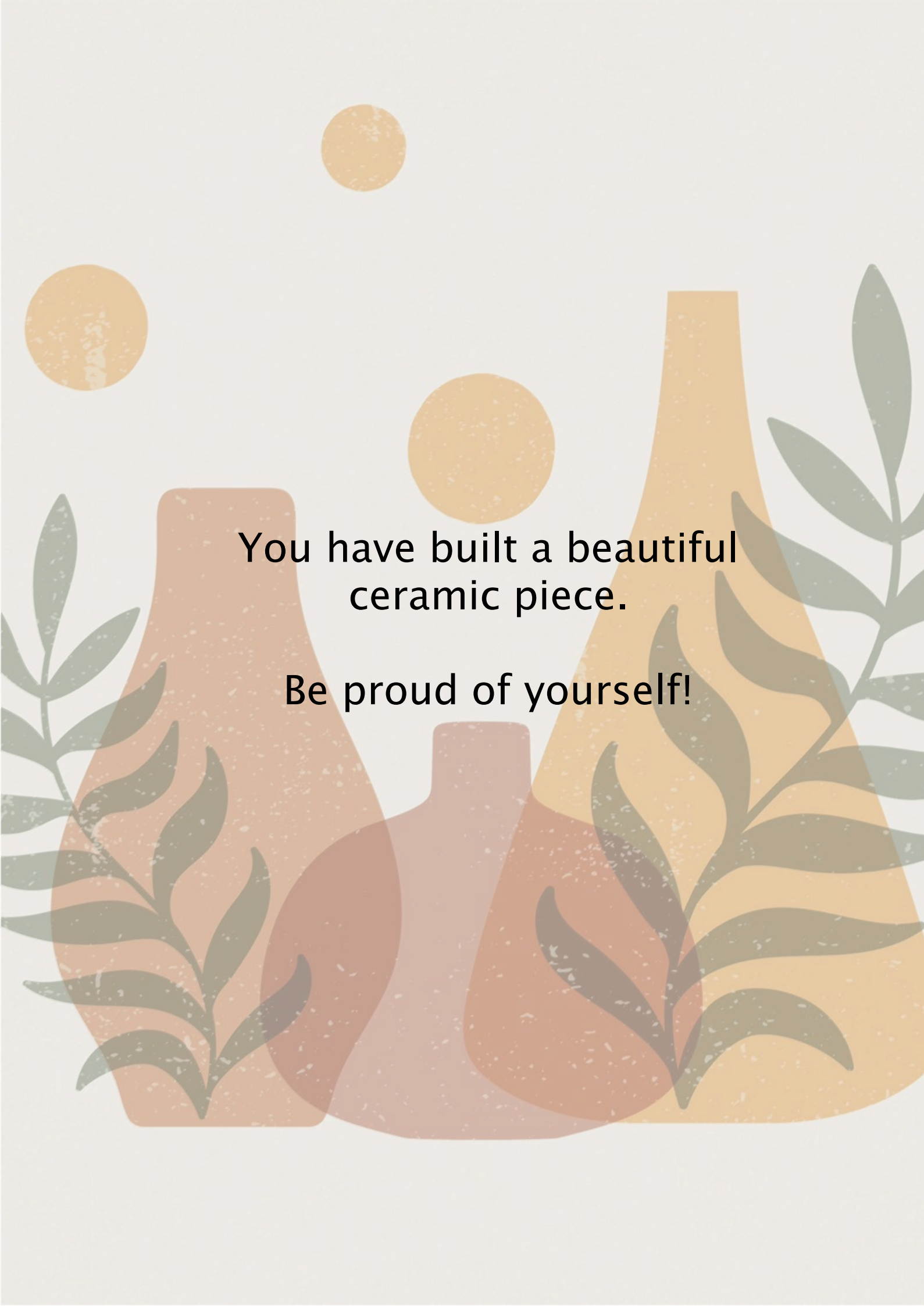




16. Smooth everything carefully.

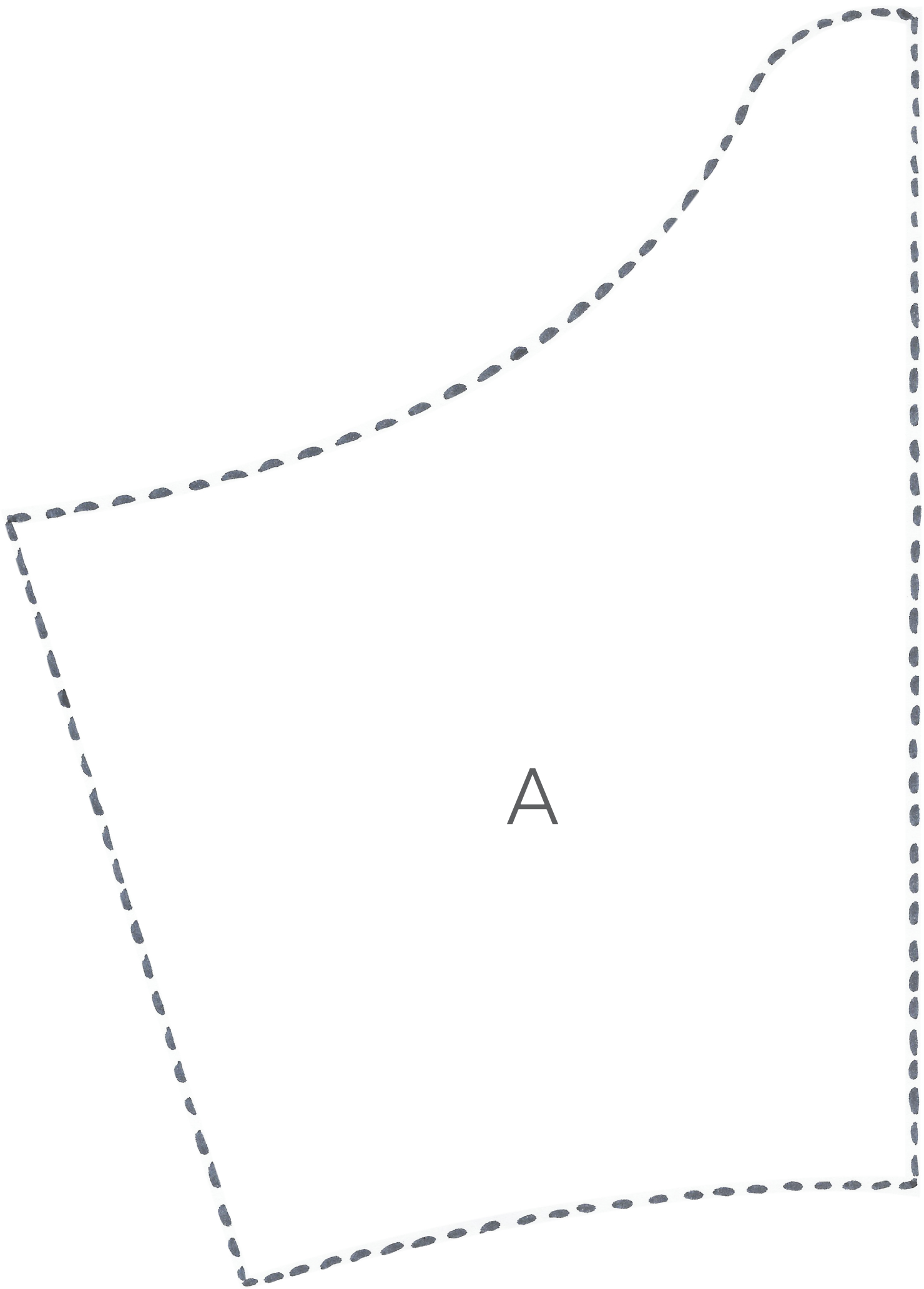
17. Refine your surface a little more with a sponge.
